Food Spills: Carefully scoop up spill, do not wipe across the surface. Blot with dry cloth.

Liquid Spills: Blot away excess with clean dry cloth turning regularly. Do not wipe across the surface.

Clean surface with a Marblesmith recommended stone or metal cleaner.

Sealing and Protecting:

Natural stone and metals can be ruined in an instant if not properly protected and cared for. The first important measure to protect your stone and metal is to make sure they are sealed. It is also important to make sure you clean your stone and metal properly using the information in this brochure.

STONE CLEANING TIPS

- ◆ Dust & Clean Surfaces Frequently
- ◆ Blot up spills immediately to minimize permanent damage
- ◆ Clean surfaces with Marblesmith recommended cleaners
- ◆ DO NOT use vinegar, bleach or ammonia based cleaners
- ◆ DO NOT use products that contain acid, such as bathroom cleaners, grout cleaners, tub cleaners or tile cleaners
- ◆ DO NOT use products that contain alkaline
- ◆ DO NOT use products not specifically designed for natural stones
- ◆ Enjoy the beauty of your stone

AFTER SERVICE CARE

The majority of damage to natural stone and metals happens with misguided care and cleaning. People invest thousands of dollars on natural stone and metals to enhance and beautify their surroundings. Then unknowingly degrade these investments by using cleaners and products not responsive to these materials. Most “general type” cleaners contain acids, ammonias and abrasives that will damage natural stone and metals. Also, keep in mind that substances like coffee, wine, juices, mustards, soft drinks and sodas will scare stones and metals whether sealed or not. Wipe up all spills immediately, before natural chemical reactions occur. Improper cleaners will cause discoloration, scratches and degrade the sealers.

METAL CLEANING TIPS

- ◆ Dust & Clean Surfaces Frequently
- ◆ Blot up spills immediately to minimize permanent damage
- ◆ Clean surfaces with Marblesmith recommended cleaners
- ◆ DO NOT use vinegar, bleach, ammonia or solvent based cleaners
- ◆ DO NOT use products that contain abrasives, such as Ajax, Brillo Pads or rubbing compound
- ◆ DO NOT use products that contain alkaline, acid or ammonia
- ◆ DO NOT use products not specifically designed for metals
